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




A Message from the Director

LGBTQ Supporters and 19th Century Spiritualism

The LGBTQ community has a long and often hidden history within the realm of spirituality and religion. In the 1800s, LGBTQ individuals who were also spiritualists faced a double stigma in society, as they were both marginalized for their sexual orientation and for their belief in communicating with the spirit world. However, despite these challenges, there were LGBTQ spiritualists who made significant contributions to the growth and development of Spiritualism during this time.



Emma Harding Britten

One notable supporter of LGBTQ spiritualist from the 1800s was Emma Harding Britten, who was a prominent author, lecturer, and Spiritualist medium. Britten was born in London in 1823 and moved to the United States in 1855, where she became involved in the Spiritualist movement. She quickly gained a reputation as a gifted medium and lecturer and wrote several influential books on Spiritualism, including "Modern American Spiritualism" and "Art Magic." Although Britten's sexual orientation was never explicitly discussed, she was found to have published two spiritual books under the pseudonym name Chevalier Louis de B. The name was a nod to the French diplomat Chevalier d'Eon who lived the first half of his life as a man in the Napoleonic Army and the second

half as a woman. The scandal of Chevalier d'Eons gender transformation made an impact on many in the 1800s who were struggling with gender identity. Later Emma would claim she channeled Chevalier Louis while living in New Zealand in the 1870s. Writing as Chevalier Louis de B. plus her close relationship with known transgender spiritualist Helena Blavatsky implied her queer supporting status. Britten also challenged gender stereotypes by actively fighting for gender equality. Also, her ability to walk in a male dominated Victorian world as a woman, engaging in religious, politics and scientific circles, says volumes of her belief in not being defined by gender.

The 1900s saw a continuation of the trend of LGBTQ individuals making significant contributions to the realm of spirituality and religion. Despite the continued stigmatization of LGBTQ people in society at large, a number of queer spiritualists emerged during this time who helped to shape the course of spiritual and religious thought in the 20th century. Despite the challenges they faced, LGBTQ spiritualists since 1848 made significant contributions to the growth and development of Spiritualism. Their work helped to legitimize the movement and to spread its teachings to a wider audience. Today, their legacy continues to inspire and inform LGBTQ individuals who seek to explore their spirituality in an open and accepting religion.

A delicious recipe for summer time fun

Watermelon prosecco sorbet slushies

Ingredients

1 watermelon (about 2kg)

200ml prosecco, plus a little extra

3 mint sprigs, plus extra to serve

½ <u>lemon</u>, zest pared

50g sugar



Step 1: Cut the watermelon into quarters and remove the pips using a teaspoon. If you're serving the same day or next day, keep six wedges or slices back for decorating and chill. Cut the flesh into 3cm cubes (you should have about 1kg fruit, with the rind discarded) and sit in a baking parchment-lined container where the cubes fit snugly. Pour the prosecco over the fruit, cover and freeze for 4 hrs, or up to 1 week.

Step 2: Put the frozen prosecco-soaked watermelon cubes in a <u>food processor</u> with the sugar syrup. Blend well, stopping and pushing the mixture towards the blades with a spatula every few seconds, if you need to, until it's a slushy consistency. Add a splash more prosecco to make a smooth slush. Spoon or pour into six chilled glasses. Garnish with the chilled watermelon wedges and little mint sprigs.



Supplies need-

Pebbles
Googly eyes
Glue Gun
Glue Sticks
Frame
Black Pen
White Paper or
Card stock



Step 1

Take two pebbles, one larger than the other, and add two googly eyes to the top of each stone. Then use the black pen to draw a smile underneath the eyes to create the dad and child's faces.

Step 2

Stick the rocks to the bottom half of a sheet of white card using the glue gun, and hold in place until the glue dries. Then use the black pen to give the rocks some arms and legs.

Step 3

Use the black pen to write "Dad you rock" above the stones on the white card. Then take the back and glass out of your frame and put your picture into the frame. Glue it into the frame if necessary as the stones can be quite heavy! Then attach the backing back onto the frame and your cute Father's Day craft is ready to surprise your dad with!
