Visiting Spirits of the American Revolution

During the American Revolution, there are a few accounts and stories that involve supernatural or paranormal elements, including ghosts, visions, and interactions with the dead. Note that these stories are often based on folklore and personal anecdotes, and their historical accuracy can be difficult to ascertain. Nonetheless, they offer interesting insights into the beliefs and experiences of people.

Here are a few examples of reported phenomena:



1. Nathan Hale, a young American spy captured and hanged by the British in 1776, is said to have appeared as a ghost to his friend Captain William Hull. According to the account, Hale's ghostly figure approached Hull and revealed information about his execution.

2. Visions of Joseph Warren: Joseph Warren, a prominent American patriot, and leader during the early stages of the Revolution, reportedly had visions that foreshadowed his death at the Battle of Bunker Hill. According to some accounts, he had premonitions and expressed his belief that he would not survive the battle.

3. The Vision of George Washington According to the legend, George Washington was said to have experienced a vision one evening while encamped at Valley Forge in the winter of 1777-1778. In the alleged vision, he saw an angel who showed him scenes from the future of America, including its eventual victory in the Revolutionary War, the establishment of the United States, and the nation's future prosperity. The most well-known version of the story comes from a written account by a man named Anthony Sherman, who claimed to have met Washington years later. However, Sherman's account was not published until 1859, long after Washington's death, and there are doubts about its accuracy. Historians generally approach this story with skepticism due to the lack of contemporary evidence and the late emergence of the accounts.

4. British General Fraser visits his wife in England on the day he died at the Battle of Saratoga in 1777. While he lay dying in America around 2 pm, he would utter his wife's name. Meanwhile, in England it was evening, and

Meanwhile, in England it was evening, and Mrs. Fraser was entertaining guests when she yelled and made a wincing pain and told her guests to leave when her friends asked her why, she told them she saw her husband killed in battle during the dinner. Her vision was confirmed weeks later when a letter arrived announcing his death on the same day of her party.

5. General "Mad"Anthony Wayne, one of Washington's senior commanders died in Northwestern Pennsylvanian in the city of Erie after the revolution in 1796. His body was originally buried in Erie, but his family asked his body be exhumed and reburied in the Southeastern part of the state at the family's cemetery plot. With the inability to move his body that far in the 1790s, a choice was made to speed up decomposition and allow his bones to travel to Rad-

nor, PA. Many claims to have seen his apparition along the US Route 322 road.

- 6. Fort Mifflin, a British fort on Mud Island along the Delaware River, south of Philadelphia is home to the screaming lady. Colonists told a tale of Elizabeth Pratt who denounced her daughter after hearing the girl fell in love with a British Officer during the time of the revolution. The girl soon died of dysentery. Elizabeth consumed with guilt will take her own life and where she once lived near, the old British Fort, sometimes people have claimed to hear a woman shrieking.
- 7. A girl carrying a lantern and the regiment of soldiers at Jockey Hollow in New Jersey are a few spirits that show up for visitors. Reports discuss the cold winters during the Revolution and how many men perished from the conditions. People have claimed to hear foot soldiers, a drummer, and talking around the location of the hollow. One 1700s tale tells of a girl who carries a lantern and wears white that can be seen in the woods at night.
- 8. HMS Jersey is considered one of the most haunted ships of the 1700s. It was a British prison ship docked in the New York East River harbor during the war. Due to the cramped and unsanitary conditions, over 12,000 Patriot prisoners were killed in the prison. The ship was still active until 1902. Multiple cases of phenomena have been recorded.
- 9. Somerville, MA, British Lieutenant Richard Browne was killed by a patriot sentry in 1778. He was shot in the face, and his commanding officer asked for a church funeral in Cambridge, the citizens of the town rioted during the service preventing a peaceful procession. Years later, multiple reports tell of an apparition of faceless colonial soldiers lingering around the church and cemetery. Many claim it is the spirit of Browne haunting the areas.

10. The story of the headless horseman has its origins in the American Revolution. Georgetown, South Carolina, Patriot **General Francis Marion** (the Swamp Fox) learned that some of his men were being held prisoner at a plantation. His spy let him know that due to a party at a neighboring plantation, only one dragoon sentry would guard the prisoners. Marion while on horseback, quickly beheaded the sen-

try and buried him in an unmarked grave on the plantation. A few days later, a slave saw a headless man staggering around the plantation, dressed in a British Uniform. And every night after, this apparition appeared on this plantation. Soon horse hoof beats would be heard before seeing the headless man. The site of the man is gruesome and often terrifies those who see him. Later Washington Irving would tell the tale with some embellishment and call it The Legend of Sleepy Hollow.



A delicious Fourth of July recipe

Dill Pickle Potato Salad

Ingredients

- 3 lbs of potatoes
- 6 hard-boiled eggs chopped
- 3 celery ribs chopped
- 6 green onions chopped

2 medium dill pickles, finely chopped

- 1 1/2 cups of mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup of dill pickle juice
- 4 1/2 tsp. mustard
- 1 tsp celery seed
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp pepper



Step 1: Place potatoes in a dutch oven or large kettle, cover and bring to a boil, reduce heat, cover and simmer for 20-30 minutes, drain and cool

Step 2: Peel and cube potatoes, place in large bowl, add eggs, celery, onions and pickles

Step 3: In a small bowl, combine mayonnaise, pickle juice, mustard, celery seed, salt and pepper until blended. Pour into large bowl and mix well

with potato mixture. Cover and refrigerate for 4 hours.


