

January 4 – Louis Braille's birthday: he was a French educator who created a reading and writing system known as "braille" for the visually impaired


January 15 – Makar Sankranti: Hindu festival dedicated to the god of the sun, Surya

Church of Peace, A Spiritualist Center is dedicated to the research of Spiritualism.

Through our research we discovered that the Rev. Bertha Crear, was the First Black American Spiritualist to hold credentials with the National Spiritualist Association and Spiritualist National Union in 1922. We were able to gather information about her and her contributions to Spiritualism. While researching, we discovered that there was only a cement number marking her burial spot in Columbus, Ohio. This saddened us.

Winter Recipes to Warm the Soul

5-Ingredient Three-Cheese Tortellini Soup

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound sausage, crumbled and browned
- 2 cans Italian stewed tomatoes
- 2 32-ounce Swanson Chicken Broth
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 20-ounce package of three-cheese tortellini

Brown sausage in a skillet.

Then put all ingredients, including cooked sausage, into a large stock pot and place on the stove on medium-low heat for about one hour, stirring occasionally.

When the tortellini starts to fatten up – but not uncurl – the soup is ready to serve.






CHURCH OF PEACE PSYCHICAL RESEARCH SCIENCE SOCIETY

<u>Ghost Hunter's Daughter</u> by Dan Poblocki



SPIRITUALISM: YESTERDAY, TODAY AND TOMORROW

Spiritualism is a religious movement that originated in the United States in the 19th century. It is based on the belief that the spirits of deceased individuals can communicate with the living through mediums. Spiritualism became popular in Washington, D.C. in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, with several prominent figures in the city becoming involved in the movement.

One of the earliest proponents of Spiritualism in Washington, D.C. was Kate Fox, one of the two sisters who are credited with starting the movement in 1848. Fox moved to the city in 1852 and established a Spiritualist community there. She held séances and claimed to be able to communicate with the dead, attracting a large following.

In addition to individual mediums, there were also several Spiritualist organizations active in Washington, D.C. during this time. The National Colored Spiritualist Association of Churches was founded in the city in the late 19th century and had over 100 member churches by the early 20th century. The organization was focused on promoting spiritual healing and the ability of individuals to communicate with the spirit world.

Despite the diversity of spiritualist organizations in Washington, DC, they all shared a belief in the ability to communicate with spirits and the importance of spiritual healing. Many of these organizations also played a role in promoting social justice and equality for African Americans.

Today, there are still a few Spiritualist organizations and individuals in the Washington,
